

Recommendations from March 13, 2006 minutes

Circulation History. Some of the SEO library directors asked that the committee re-consider the 9 day period for keeping circulation history and to reduce that to one day. Those directors who responded to Chris's e-mail were evenly split between 9 days and 1 day. After considerable discussion Sheila Perkins moved and Mike Wantz seconded a motion to reduce the period to one day pending further research by SEO staff on how the one day is calculated by the system. Motion passed unanimously. However, further research by Dianna Clark has found that there could be issues in tracking items in transit if this is done. Chris Tucker will take this issue back to the Governance Committee for another vote once more research is done.

Maximum number of claimed returned. Mike Wantz moved and Arlene Radden seconded a motion to retain the standard of maximum number of claimed returned at 3 for those libraries that wish to use this status and that owning libraries be notified if their item is put in claimed returned by another library. Motion passed unanimously.

Maximum number of renewals. Harold Showalter moved and Becky Coker seconded a motion to set the default for the maximum number of renewals at 2 with libraries having the option of one exception of zero renewals on certain itypes OR btypes. The zero exception would only apply at the home location of the item. Motion passed unanimously.
