Mango Languages



Mango is an online language-learning system that can help you learn languages like Spanish, French, Japanese, Brazilian Portuguese, German, Mandarin Chinese, Greek, Italian, Russian and more. It also offers English language lessons if English is not your first language.

Access:

The Mango Languages collections can be accessed from within the State Library of Ohio and many state agency buildings using the library homepage (www.library.ohio.gov) or remotely using OhioLINK.

From within the State Library of Ohio and many state agency buildings:

- Select "State Employees" on the library homepage. From there, click "Mango Languages" from the list of links.

Remotely using OhioLINK:

- From the library homepage, select "Access OhioLINK Resources" and then select "Access OhioLINK Resources from Any Other Location".
- Enter your last name and the last nine digits of your State Library of Ohio library card.

Select the "L-M" link under "Databases Listed by Name." Scroll down this page to "Mango Language Learning Center."
