Beverly Cain to be next State Librarian of Ohio

The State Library of Ohio is pleased to announce that the State Library Board has appointed Beverly Cain to be the new State Librarian of Ohio beginning June 1, 2010. Cain has 23 years of library experience in Ohio and has been the Director of the Portsmouth Public Library System since 1997. "I'm certainly pleased by the Board's appointment of Beverly Cain as the State Librarian of Ohio," said Board President Lynn Grimshaw. "I know that she did a great job in Scioto County and I have every reason to believe that she will do a similar job at the State Library."

Beverly will return to the Columbus area where she was the Branch Manager at the Upper Arlington Public Library Lane Road Branch from 1992 to 1997. Prior to that, she worked at the Medina County District Library from 1988 to 1992, first as a Reference Librarian and then as a Manager of Reference and Adult Services.

Because these publications are in PDF format, **they contain all of the illustrations** included with each article. MasterFILE Premiere has many other popular publications in HTML format (including Time, Newsweek and Smithsonian) that are text-only.

To get to MasterFILE Premiere, start with our home page <http://library.ohio.gov> and click on **State Employees** at the top.

On the next screen, click on **OhioLINK Resources** and then on **Access OhioLINK Databases from any other**

location. At some point you will be asked to choose State Library of Ohio as your institution and then your name (last/first) and then your number (last nine digits on your card).

Once you are on the OhioLINK Databases menu screen, choose **L-M** under **Listed by Name** and then scroll down to and click on MasterFILE Premiere. Click on **Publications** in the blue bar at the top of the next screen. The quickest way to then find your publication is to enter the name in the **second box** and click on **Browse**.

If your publication is included in MasterFILE Premiere, it will appear at the top of the list on the next screen, along with an indication of whether it is in full-text – PDF or HTML. If it is, click on the title and you will see all the years covered on the right side of the screen. All of the articles are yours to read and/or print when you click on the desired year and then issue.
