The Ohio eBook Project offers access to thousands of eBooks, audiobooks, music tiles and videos. All you need is a library card from the State Library of Ohio to get started finding these great materials.

## Finding Materials:

There are two ways to find materials through the Ohio eBook Project.

### Library Catalog:

- The first is by using our library catalog located at [www.library.ohio.gov](http://www.library.ohio.gov) to search for books. You will see an  eBook or an  eAudiobook symbol on the records for these materials.
- You can click the link in these records to access the eBook or audiobook.



## Installing Free OverDrive Software:

Prior to downloading an audiobook, eBook, music or video title for the first time, you will need to install free software designed to enhance your reading, listening or viewing experience.

- Locate the software links on the Ohio eBook Project website.
- When you click each link, a "Help" page will open with instructions and system requirements for the installation.
- Follow the instructions to complete the installation.



## Checking Out Materials:

Once you have located your materials and have downloaded the OverDrive software, you are ready to check out.

- First, add your selections to your cart.  
NOTE: If a title is not available, you can place a hold on the item and you will receive an email when the item is ready to be checked out.
- Click the "Proceed to Checkout" link and select the "State Library of Ohio" from the drop-down menu. Then enter your library card number.
- Then, select the "Download" link and enjoy your titles!
- At the end of the loan period, titles will expire and be automatically 'returned' to the library. At this time, you can delete the expired file(s) from your computer.
