Let the Experts Help with Current Awareness Service

Topic Alerts and Table of Contents from your favorite publications emailed to you

The amount of information that is available for professional growth can be overwhelming. The academic journals, magazines and other publications to help you remain up to date in your field have varied publishers, formats and publication dates. To help you navigate the mountain of information, the State Library has a service called **Current Awareness**. This service consists of two aspects that deliver the Table of Contents [TOC] from specific journals and Topic Alerts.




The Table of Contents service is a selection of journals and magazines within the OhioLINK electronic resources (databases) which can be emailed to you as soon as they are published electronically. Table of Contents selections come with a listing of the contents and a link to the article when applicable. If we do not have immediate digital access to the article, our librarians can Interlibrary Loan (ILL) the article from an institution that holds the publication. You may request articles by contacting us at

Topic Alerts are created by the State Library and delivered via e-mail when relevant journal articles are available. These are unique to the state employee from requested specific topics of interest. To receive customized research updates on topics relevant to your work, go to the Topic Alert page of the State Library of Ohio website. Please enter as much information as you think will assist us in setting up your alert. The best results are from searches that are not too broad. We will contact you by phone to clarify your topic and help set up the best possible search.
